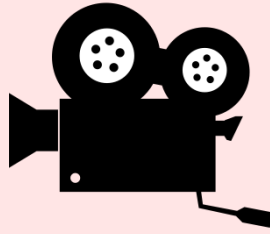
Jasmine Bennet Choreography

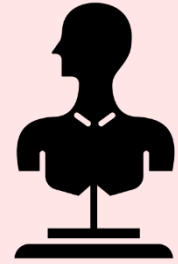
Film Making
